



# NDIS eligibility checklist for people with a mental health condition

## Assessment questions

### 1: Is the person aged under 65

- No            The person does not meet the NDIA access criteria
- Yes            Go to question 2

### 2: Is the person an Australian citizen, permanent resident or special visa holder?

- No            The person does not meet the NDIA access criteria
- Yes            Go to question 3

### 3: Does the person have a diagnosed mental health condition or other disability?

- No            The person is unlikely to meet the NDIA access criteria at this time
- Yes            Go to question 4

### 4: Does the person have a diagnosed mental health condition or other disability?

- No            their condition can be managed through clinical and medical treatment along with group psychosocial supports and occasional one on one support.  
  
The person is unlikely to meet the NDIA access criteria at this time
- Yes            both medical and multi-agency psychosocial treatments are needed  
  
Go to question 5
- Unsure        both medical and multi-agency psychosocial treatments are needed  
  
Go to question 5



**5: Was the mental health condition or psychosocial disability first recognised more than a year ago?**

- No            it was only recognised recently  
The person is unlikely to meet the NDIA access criteria at this time
- Yes            Go to question 6

**6: Has the person previously, or is the person currently receiving treatment\* for their mental health condition?**

- No            The person is unlikely to meet the NDIA access criteria at this time
- Yes            Go to question 7

*\*Treatment may include medications, psychological therapies, cultural practices as well as services provided by community mental health providers.*

**7: Does the person struggle to find employment or participate in the community because of their mental health condition or disability?**

- No            The person is unlikely to meet the NDIA access criteria at this time
- Yes            Go to question 8 – over the page



**8: What is the impact of the person’s mental health condition or disability on their functional capacity?**
